#### Game Notes

- Rosemont continues its stretch run seeking a playoff spot in the Colonial States Athletic Conference tournament with a game against Wilson.
- The Ravens have been off for eight days due to the bye in the CSAC schedule. When they last hit the court, they had eight players score more than eight points during an 88-56 win over Keystone at Alumnae Hall
- Jacob Simonson was named to the CSAC Honor Roll this week after a three-game stretch that saw him score 27 points in a win over Arcadia on Jan. 21 and a team high 14 points in the win over Keystone last Saturday.
- The Ravens 9.6 steals per game average is good for 26th in the nationwide NCAA rankings heading into play on Friday out of 416 Division III teams. They are 28th in the country in turnovers forced with 17.9 per game.
- The Phoenix are coming off a 96-80 win over Keystone on Wednesday night to strengthen their hold on second place in the CSAC standings. Wilson is lead by junior forward Rashaan Bean, who is averaging 16.1 points a game along with 5.6 rebounds. Keion Adams (14.8) and Zachary Powell (10.9) also average in double figures. Adams averages eight rebounds per game as well.
