Game Notes

- The Ravens will try to snap its five game losing streak and win a second game at home when Bard College comes to the Athletic Complex for a Wednesday afternoon contest.
- Rosemont attacker Ben Koszelak (pictured below) became the second player in Ravens lacrosse history to break the 100 goal mark when he scored the third of four goals on Saturday afternoon in the 18-11 loss to Immaculata. Koszelak trails only Stephen Licata (116 goals) all-time in the goals scoring category in the Rosemont record book. So far on the 2019 season, the senior has 21 goals in six games to lead the Ravens in scoring.
- Rosemont is in its first season under new head coach Ernie Shapiro. Shapiro- an assistant coach on the Ravens staff in 2018- replaces David Baker, who resigned after two seasons as head coach to spend more time with his family. Shapiro was promoted from Offensive Coordinator and Face off Coach at Rosemont College. Prior to that he was the Offensive Coordinator and Faceoff Coach at Immaculata University. In 2013 he returned to his high school alma mater, Lower Merion HS. As the Head Coach for three years hie teams played in the PIAA State Tournament twice.
