Game Notes

- The Colonial States Athletic Conference playoffs continue tonight from Alumnae Hall as top seed Rosemont puts its 17 game winning streak on the line against sixth-seed Wilson College.
- Ravens senior center Ashley Murray was named Colonial States Athletic Conference Women's Basketball Player of the Year in voting announced by the conference on Monday. Joining Murray on the first team was senior point guard Ayanna Thompson. Junior forward Ke'alohilani Naone-Carter was honored with her third All-CSAC Second Team honor. And Rosemont head coach Rayne Reber was named CSAC Coach of The Year.
- The Ravens average margin of victory during the CSAC's 16 regular season wins has been 32.1 points per game. Rosemont's lowest margin of victory in a CSAC game was nine points in a victory over Wilson on Dec. 1. Every game of Rosemont's 17 game winning streak has been decided by double figures.
- Wilson upset three-seed Notre Dame on the road Monday night by a 47-37 margin in the CSAC Quarterfinals. Kai Wyatt had 13 points while Lindsay Purvis added 12. As mentioned before, Wilson is the only CSAC opponent to stay within double digits during the regular season.
