Game Notes

- Winners of six of their last seven games, Rosemont returns home to Alumnae Hall after a 28 day absence to face an old Colonial States Athletic Conference rival - Neumann University.
- Rosemont took the tournament title at Lycoming College on New Year's weekend. Senior center Ashley Murray was named the tournament MVP averaging 18 points and 15 rebounds in the two games. Ke'alohilani Naone-Carter was also named to the all-tournament team.
- The Ravens have owned the glass and played remarkable team basketball. Through the first 11 games of the season, Rosemont is outrebounding its opponents by 45.2-38.0 margin- a whopping 7.2 rebounds per contest. They also have averaged 15.1 assists per game- four more than their opponents per contest.
- The Knights are coming off a second place finish in the Catholic University of America tournament, falling to the host in the championship game. They are lead by senior guard Nafisa Saunders, who is averaging 24.8 points per game. Minika Glenn averages 14.1 points per game as the second leading scorer for the Knights.
