## Game Notes

- The season tips off this afternoon as the Ravens host Penn State-Brandywine for the first game of the season for both teams.
- The Ravens are coming off a 15-11 campaign in 2017-18 which saw them advance to the Colonial States Athletic Conference playoffs for the fourth time in the past five seasons.
- Two Ravens starters are eyeing potential milestones as the season gets underway. Senior point guard Ayanna Thompson will start the season with a school record 365 assists. She could become one of ten women in CSAC history with over 400 assists. No current CSAC school has a player with over 400 assist while being a member of the conference.
- Ke'Alohilani Naone-Carter starts the 2018-19 season with 789 points. The junior who has been on the CSAC's All-Conference second team the past two seasons would become the ninth player in Ravens history to join the 1,000 point club.
- Rosemont was picked first in the pre-season poll of CSAC Coaches with six first place votes and 78 points. Centenary was picked second with 69 points and two first place votes. Cairn (49 points) and Keystone (46 points) rounded out the top 4.
