Game Notes

- The Ravens will play its second straight home game and its first home contest within the Colonial States Athletic Conference when the Gators of Notre Dame (Md.) come to the Athletic Complex on Wednesday night.
- The Ravens are being coached by former Neumann standout ShaeLynn Risely, who takes over as head coach of the program. Risely scored 105 goals, adding 28 assists and 119 ground balls during her four year career with the Knights. The Ridley High graduate was named All-CSAC honors in 2014 (Second Team), 2016 (Honorable Mention) and 2017 (Honorable Mention). After her playing career ended in 2017, she was a coach at Penncrest High School for the 2018 season.
- Maciana Mazzeo has been the leading goal scorer for the Ravens this season, scoring four times and adding an assist. She scored three times last week in games against Penn State Abington and the Colonial States Athletic Conference opener against Keystone College on Saturday. Mazzeo was also a second-team All-CSAC women's soccer player in the fall.
