Game Notes

- The Colonial States Athletic Conference playoffs conclude tonight at Alumnae Hall as top seed Rosemont puts its 18 game winning streak on the line against second-seed Keystone College with an NCAA Division III championships berth on the line.
- The Ravens are coming off a strong defensive effort in Thursday night's 70-41 win over Wilson College. Rosemont held the Phoenix to just 30.2 percent shooting from the floor in the semifinal win. It continues a trend during the regular season. Rosemont is in the top 10 in the nation out of 423 Division III schools in lowest opponent's field goal percentage at 32.2 percent.
- Ravens senior center Ashley Murray was named Colonial States Athletic Conference Women's Basketball Player of the Year in voting announced by the conference on Monday. Joining Murray on the first team was senior point guard Ayanna Thompson. Junior forward Ke'alohilani Naone-Carter was honored with her third All-CSAC Second Team honor. And Rosemont head coach Rayne Reber was named CSAC Coach of The Year.
- The Giants have won six in a row, including a 69-60 win over Cairn on Thursday night to advance to the championship game. They are lead by Mac Oribello, a first team All-CSAC player and Rookie of the Year who averages 18.5 points per game.
